College basketball coaches across the nation look to raise over \$500,000 with event

LAS VEGAS, NV - May 16, 2016 - College basketball coaches from across the nation will team up May 22-24 for the American Cancer Society's 9th annual Coaches vs. Cancer Las Vegas Golf Classic hosted by MGM Grand. "It's great to see so many new faces involved with the event this year as well as the coaches and golfers who support the event year after year," Kruger said. On Monday evening, May 23, the Jabbawockeez – the world's most-popular hip hop dance crew – will perform for the private "Bigger Monday" party at MGM Grand. The band Elvis Monroe and comedian John DiCrosta from Brad Garrett's Comedy Club at MGM Grand will also make appearances.
